Physical, Dental, Eye Exams Eye Exams are required for students entering kindergarten and

students enrolling from out of state.

Physicals are required by the State of Illinois for students entering kindergarten, sixth grade, and students enrolling from out of state. The sixth grade physical also covers sports.

Fifth grade through eighth grade students will need a sports physical to participate in school sponsored sports.

Dentals are required by the State of Illinois for students entering grade, and students enrolling from out of state.

Dental, physical and eye exam forms must be in the school office by the first day of school.

Sports Physicals are needed before participation in the sports program. Forms are available on our website.

framework for the ceiling is being constructed, with each room featuring a long two-tiered curve. The large backflow prevention valve for the incoming city water was installed in the tower. Power has been hooked up to the electrical system. Our ECC Brochure will be printing this week. Our marketing team hopes to put up a table display at the Gateway Grizzlies baseball game on Sunday, May 31 when our GSLS Band will play the national anthem. Early Childhood Center Update

On the back side of the ECC, brick laying and insulation of the outer wall is moving quickly with a crew of 12 workers. Inside, on the HVAC system, each room is getting a ceiling-mounted heating and cooling booster unit, just like the grade school. After installation the units are connected to the primary heating and cooling plant, to electrical power, and to thermostats. Light fixtures are being wired with power and switches. As the bathroom walls are nearly finished, water pipes are put through the walls to the location of sinks and toilets.
