
Something to Consider:

What are our 3-6 year olds learning at Good Shepherd? Our Director, Mrs. Bedard, gave a 45-minute overview this summer for Bible Class. "The things I've been talking about are the individual spiritual life and how we incorporate worship. Now I'm going to talk about life in the sheepfold, and that is, getting along. The primary learning thing that happens in Preschool is what we call social-emotional skills, and self-regulation. It's those things that are greater indicators of success in school and life than any academic thing that children will learn."
