### Ag Family Science Night

Good Shepherd Lutheran School hosted an Ag Family Science night on Thursday, February 25 for students and their families from preschool through third grade. Almost 90 people were in attendance for the evening events that was presented by the Madison County CA-REE/Ag in the Classroom organization along with help from many of the schools teachers. Participants visited six stations where they explored topics related to science and agriculture. Students learned the importance of pollination for plant growth, planted wheat seeds, learned about plants that grow above the ground and below the ground. A favorite station was the Edible Soil, presented by Miss Madison County Fair Queen, P.
