The winning class for the Box Tops and Labels Program contest for the month of March is Mrs. Pritchard (3-2). Mrs. Pritchard's students collected 742 box tops and labels with an average of 37 per student.

We ended February with a total of 19,462 box tops and labels and added 2,210 more this month, for a total of 21,672 box tops and labels collected so far this school year.
