Something to Consider:


Share with God's people who are chores to do, the kids are wrestling in need. Practice hospitality.

Without this selection, LESA will be unable to view the application, and as a result, students will not have access to LESA funding. Remember, all scholarship applications must be submitted with all documentation submitted prior to March 15th to have the best possible opportunity for scholarships.

TRACKS Workers Needed

Good Shepherd's Before and After School Program has two part-time job openings. Both are paid positions for adults 18+. The first job is a morning shift of Monday through Friday, from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. (10 hours per week). The individual would work independently to open the TRACKS area, welcome and check-in students from first through eighth grade, and monitor them while they play until dismissal to their classrooms. The second job is a substitute who works only on an as-needed basis. The substitute would be on-call to work a shift whenever a regular staff member is unavailable due to doctor's appointments, personal illness, etc. The substitute might work the morning shift, or the afternoon shift of 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. The afternoon shift also includes monitoring children outside the school building on the playground, and helping children with homework.
