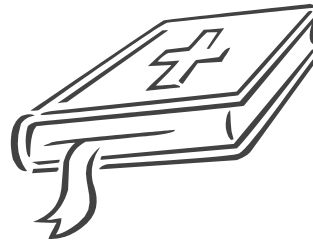

Lost a Loved One Through Death

GRIEFSHARE, is a grief recovery support group. No matter what the circumstances, grief recovery is a painful process. On Tuesday, September 12, 2017 at 6pm we will begin a new session of GriefShare, a special weekly seminar and support group for people who are grieving the death of a loved one.

Each GriefShare session includes a video seminar and group discussion. A workbook assists you with note taking, journaling and grief study. The videos feature top experts on grief recovery, reenactments about living with grief and real-life stories of people who have experienced losses like yours. During the small group discussion time, you'll have the opportunity to interact with others who experienced a recent loss, learn about their experiences and share your own.

The facilitators are Kathy Bohnet and Lynn Cook. Please join us for the first session held at Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, in the Conference Room. It should last about 2 hours. There will be a \$15.00 fee for the workbook. Scholarships are available upon request. Please register by e-mailing lcook-parishnurse@charter.net or phone the church secretary 344-3151. Arrival and Departure-Safety First

Patience..... This is the key to safe arrival and departure. Share this with your child's driver.

Always...Be careful when backing your car some students are not very tall.

Drive slowly – when arriving and departing. (Remind your teenager driver).

Drive according to the direction of parking spaces. Use the crosswalks and never walk between cars.

Please do not...Never, ever pass a car. This is VERY dangerous.

Do not park along the front of the building – even for a short period of time.

During dismissal you may park before the entrance to the church, but not after.

Before School...Please do not park or have a prolonged stop in the drop off lane (Yellow curb). Pull into a parking spot instead.

Drop off along the front of school and the J curve only.

Children can walk the length of the sidewalk

to the front door of the school. You do not have to pull directly in front of the school for drop off. This will help so we do not have long lines.

The front doors will open at 7:45 a.m.

After School...

It is best to park and wait for your child to come to your car or park and walk to the school entrance to meet your child.

Please do not honk your horn and remember to be patient!

Please do not park in front of the church as you wait to pick up someone.

Tardy Slips

All students arriving late to school must have a tardy slip to enter the classroom after the bell has rung. When you sign in your child, they will be given a tardy slip to take to the teacher. Arriving late due to an appointment, please bring an excuse from the doctor's or dentist's office.

Visitors

All parents picking up or dropping off their child during school hours will need to stop in the office and sign out your child. Security for the children is important to us. All visitors who come into the school building during the school hours will be identified by wearing a visitor's badge. When an individual signs in the school office, they will be issued a badge.

Charger Bucks-Scrip

Weekly orders will be processed on Monday, August 21 & 28, Sept. 18 & 25. (have your order in the school office by 9:00a.m.)

Walk-up sales will resume on Fridays from 3:00 - 3:30 p.m. and will continue on Sunday mornings between services. Please remember to fill out a new registration form for this school year along with your first order!!!!

The Scrip Program is a tuition reduction program for Good Shepherd Lutheran School families and friends. We strongly encourage all Good Shepherd families to purchase their groceries, gasoline, clothing and other goods and services using the SCRIP gift certificates. 50% of your credits earned may go toward the reduction of your tuition or you may donate your credits toward Good Shepherd Lutheran School's General Fund. Dear Parent/Guardian: Children need healthy meals to learn. **Good Shepherd Lutheran School** offers healthy meals every school day. Lunch costs **\$2.75**. Your children may qualify for free meals or for reduced price meals. Reduced price is **\$0.40** for lunch. To apply for free or reduced-price meals, use the Household Eligibility Application, which is enclosed. We cannot approve an application that is not complete, so be sure to fill out all required information. Return the completed application to Good Shepherd Lutheran School. Your children may qualify for free or reduced price meals if your household income falls at or below the limits on this chart.
