#### **Routines and Procedures**

#### Late and Early Departure

#### Lost a Loved One Through Death

GRIEFSHARE, is a grief recovery support group. No matter what the circumstances, grief recovery is a painful process. On Tuesday, September 12, 2017 at 6pm we will begin a new session of GriefShare, a special weekly seminar and support group for people who are grieving the death of a loved one.

Each GriefShare session includes a video seminar and group discussion. A workbook assists you with note taking, journaling and grief study. The videos feature top experts on grief recovery, reenactments about living with grief and real-life stories of people who have experienced losses like yours. During the small group discussion time, you'll have the opportunity to interact with others who experienced a recent loss, learn about their experiences and share your own.

#### Arrival and Departure-Safety First

Patience..... This is the key to safe arrival and departure. Share this with your child's

driver.

Always...Be careful when backing your car some students are not very tall.

Drive slowly - when arriving and departing. (Remind your teenage driver).

Drive according to the direction of parking spaces. Use the crosswalks and never walk between cars.

Please do not...Never, ever pass a car.

This is VERY dangerous.

Do not park along the front of the building - even for a short period of time.

During dismissal you may park before the entrance to the church, but not after.

Before School...Please do not park or have a prolonged stop in the drop off lane (Yellow curb). Pull into a parking spot instead.

Drop off along the front of school and the J curve only.

Children can walk the length of the sidewalk to the front door of the school. You do not have to pull directly in front of the school for drop off. This will help so we do not have long lines.

The front doors will open at 7:45 a.m. After School...

It is best to park and wait for your child to come to your car or park and walk to the school entrance to meet your child.

Please do not honk your horn and remember to be patient!

Please do not park in front of the church as you wait to pick up someone.

Dear Parent/Guardian: Children need healthy meals to learn. **Good Shepherd Lutheran School** offers healthy meals every school day. Lunch costs **\$2.75**. Your children may qualify for free meals or for reduced price meals. Reduced price is *\$0,40* for lunch. To apply for free or reduced-price meals, use the Household Eligibility Application, which is enclosed. We cannot approve an application that is not complete, so be sure to fill out all required information. Return the completed application to Good Shepherd Lutheran School. Your children may qualify for free or reduced price meals if your household income falls at or below the limits on this chart.
