Reminder... Absent From School

If your child will be absent, please call the school office each morning so both the office and the teacher are informed. If your child is sick, he/she needs to stay at home. Remember, your child must be fever free WITHOUT the use of acetaminophen or ibuprofen for 24 hours before returning to school. Please do not expose other children unnecessarily. A doctor's written excuse is needed to return to school if was seen by a doctor. Always bring a note to the teacher when your child returns to school.

TRACKS: On-Site Student Gathering Spot

Need a place for your student to go before school starts, or after school ends? Good Shepherd's before and after school program, nicknamed TRACKS, is a convenient, on-site place for children to play or do homework. TRACKS is for all kids in first through eighth grade. We're open mornings from 6:00-7:45 a.m. and in the afternoon from 3:15-6:00 p.m. Students are logged into the system and charged \$3.00 and a portion there of for the hour. Payment is once/month through TADS. Most mornings we have 10 - 20 students, and most afternoons 30 - 45 students. The kids love to play with their friends, and we go outside every afternoon (weather permitting).

Homework can be done with or without our assistance, and after school it's done in the comfort of the Youth Room couches. Supervision is provided by Mr. Usery, Isabella and Hannah.

Scholarships for 2018-2019 School Year

Please note that if you are applying for a scholarship for the 2018-2019 school year you will need to select "Lutheran Elementary School Association" (LESA) Building Blocks Scholarships on the online application. It is through this selection that the application information will be made available for LESA's review and award consideration. Without this selection, LESA will be unable to view the application, and as a result, students will not have access to LESA funding.

*Remember, all TADS financial aid applications must be submitted with all documentation submitted prior to March 15th to have the best possible opportunity for scholarships.

Invest in Kids

Additionally, this year you may be eligible for the Invest in Kids Scholarship. Initially, students whose families earn 300% of the federal poverty level or less for the previous year before he or she

initially receives a scholarship under the program (\$73,800 for a family of four) qualify. Once a student receives a scholarship, his or her family can earn up to 400% of the federal poverty level (\$98,400 for a family of four). Scholarship forms are available on the school website. Students entering Kindergarten-Full Day, and Grades 1 - 8 are eligible for financial aid. Financial Aid may be available to Good Shepherd Lutheran Church members from GSLC. If you are a member of GSLC, please include your preschool students on your application. Remember, early submission of financial aid applications afford you the best possible opportunity for financial aid. All applications should be complete prior to March 15, 2018.
