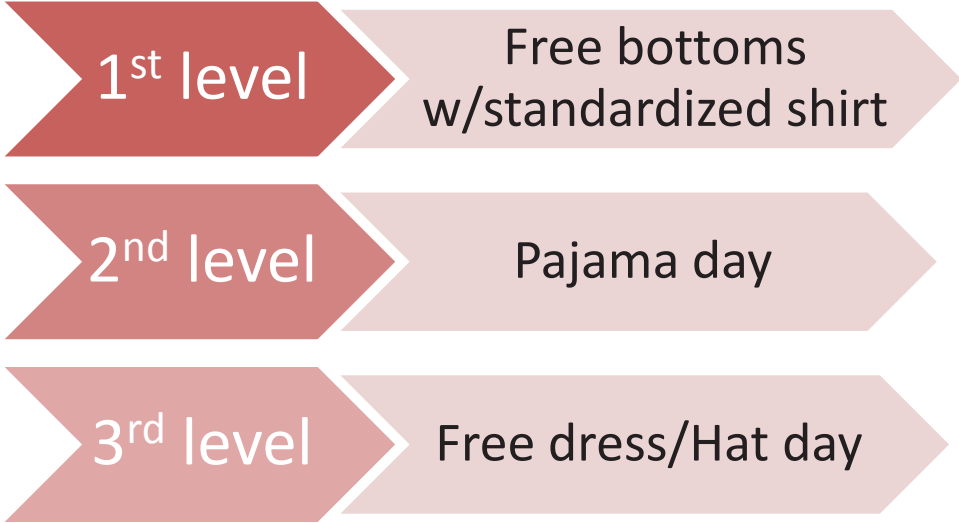
To benefit the education at Good Shepherd

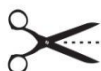
