### **TRACKS: On-Site Student Gathering Spot**

Need a place for your student to go before school starts, or after school ends? Good Shepherd's before and after school program, nicknamed TRACKS, is a convenient, on-site place for children to play or do homework. TRACKS is for all kids in first through eighth grade. We're open mornings from 6:00-7:45 a.m. and in the afternoon from 3:15-6:00 p.m. Students are logged into the system and charged \$3.00 and a portion there of for the hour. Payment is once/month through TADS. Most mornings we have 10 - 20 students, and most afternoons 30 - 45 students. The kids love to play with their friends, and we go outside every afternoon (weather permitting). Homework can be done with or without our assistance, and after school it's done in the comfort of the Youth Room couches. Supervision is provided by Mrs. Swain, Kastilla, Mary, Maximus, and Caleb.
