Parking Lot Reminders

The safety of your child is the most important thing and not, can I get out of here in a hurry!

As a reminder to all drivers and people walking in the parking lots.....

*Use the crosswalk and don't just walk across without looking first! Beware of cars backing out, don't just walk behind them, they may not see you.

*Please drive slowly when arriving and departing. It is important as a driver, be aware that children/parents are walking in the parking lot.

*Please, no cell phone usage during arrivals and dismissals.

*Those students in Kindergarten and ECC, plus siblings use the lower drop off and pick up doors.

*Parents, if you have students in 1st grade and up use the main doors for drop off and pick up.

*Upper parking lot, drivers use the main drop off "yellow line" as a quick way to drop off. Otherwise, use the J-curve and students can then use the crosswalk.
