

On a positive note, we do have milk for student lunches and our student body has received it very well! Please continue to send lunch to school with your student(s) until a new hot lunch program is established.

I thank God every day for the supportive families that go out of their way to help and the opportunity we have to share Christ each day at Good Shepherd Lutheran School.

Dear Parents,

I'm excited to tell you about a very special program I'm coordinating at our school in conjunction with Crayola. It's called Crayola ColorCycle – an amazing program devised to repurpose used markers rather than sending them to landfills!

The ColorCycle program has repurposed more than 70 tons of expended markers in the United States and Canada since 2013, and uses the most advanced plastic conversion technologies available today to make wax compounds for asphalt and roofing shingles as well as to generate electricity that can be used to heat homes, cook food, and power vehicles.

All around Good Shepherd, students and teachers will be collecting used markers that are ready to be discarded. Please help support our efforts by sending your kids in with any used markers you may have around the house- even non-Crayola brands! Highlighters and dry erase markers can also be included. Drop-off boxes will be located around the school for your child to deposit the markers.

Thank you in advance for participating! With the help of parents like you across the country, the Crayola Color-Cycle program can continue to keep tons of plastic out of landfills each year.
