As you are aware, we started the year without a hot lunch program. Although we searched for the right person to manage this program in-house, we were unsuccessful and therefore we reached out to several food services companies. We felt fortunate to find a company that is serving other area Christian schools and was interested in serving our school. After many meetings, and much consideration, the School Board and I agreed to hire them as our hot lunch provider.

Unfortunately, earlier this week, the company informed me that they decided they could not serve our school. As you can imagine I was caught off-guard and disappointed as we planned to begin the program when we return to school after Labor Day.

At this time, I have reposted the position as a Food Service Director in our church and community and there is a job description available in the school office. As a family, I am looking for your help in this search. Please consider sharing this opportunity with your friends, family and community.

On a positive note, we do have milk for student lunches and our student body has received it very well! Please continue to send lunch to school with your student(s) until a new hot lunch program is established.

I thank God every day for the supportive families that go out of their way to help and the opportunity we have to share Christ each day at Good Shepherd Lutheran School.
