COVID Updates: Reporting Student Absences

Please notify the teacher and Mr. Mayhew if you feel your student will be out of school more than one day. Your child can do synchronous learning with their class.

Arriving Late

If you arrive after school has started, 8:15 am., please do not leave until the school has a confirmed, required self-health certification and your child has been permitted to come into the building.

Student Water Bottles

Please make sure your child has a water bottle **every day with their last name on it**. A suggestion would be to have **two water bottles.** One to bring back and forth and the other left at school. Students may only use water fountains to FILL their water bottle.

Temperature Checks and Health Certification

Please verify your child(ren)'s health every day **prior to drop off, including before school care (TRACKS)**. **If your child is sick, you will still need to complete the form**. To help your wait time, please consider picking up your student(s) at 3:20 or 3:25 p.m. Check out the attached map for the traffic flow for after school pickup of students in grades 1-8. Please make sure every driver picking up has the required signage in their vehicle.

Morning Arrival Dropoff

Drivers for students in grades 1-8, please use two lanes and drop off at the main entrance, assure your child is wearing a face covering, and wait until he/she is admitted to the building. Please do not block the road to the ECC builling. ECC and Kindergarten students should enter through the west doors (near the ball field). Every driver should display the required signage in their vehicle.

TRACKS - Before/After School Care Safety Steps

*Morning TRACKS Students - Parents, please complete health screening at home. Do not leave school before your child is authorized into the building.

*No adults are allowed in the building, other than staff.

*Four different rooms can be utilized to allow for social distancing.

*Students are seated to retain their established classroom grouping. *Face coverings are required indoors, except while eating/drinking.Eating snacks outdoors is encouraged, maintaining social distance. No sharing of snacks or water bottles is allowed.

*Bathroom trips are limited to one person at a time. Handwashing/hand sanitizing is continuously encouraged.

*Sanitizing of chairs and tables is done before and after students arrive for AM and PM care.

*Students are encouraged to bring small activities from home to use when outdoor play is not available due to weather. Home activities cannot be shared.



Good Shepherd Lutheran School Daily Home Screening for Students

Please use this link to complete and submit a student's home screening results: https://forms.gie/bhd5KdtJs2acsPdu9

- Face covering is needed to enter the building.
- Please do not give your child Tylenol to mask the temperature and then send them to school.
- When should the home screening be performed?

Home screenings are to be completed the morning before each school day. Ideally, the evaluation should be completed and submitted before you commute to school. Before the student enters the school, a faculty member will verify that the student's screening data has been submitted.

- Does the screening have to be performed on the morning of the school day? Yes, the home screening must be completed and submitted on the morning of the school day.
- Can the student be screened at the school entrance?
 We are asking families to complete and submit all student screenings BEFORE coming to the school door to be checked in. This approach will help to reduce the amount of time required to check-in each student. The parent will have to do this prior to the student being able to enter the building.
- How do I submit the screening results?

Simply click the link above and follow the instructions on the form. After the form is submitted, there will be a link that allows you to fill out additional forms if needed. (A separate form is required for each student.) Please answer the questions as accurately as possible.

What type of device can I use to submit the form?

You can use a desktop computer, tablet, or smartphone. The only requirement is a data connection. For convenience, it is recommended that you save a shortcut to the form so that you can easily access it every morning.

 I have multiple children who attend Good Shepherd. Is a separate form required for each child?

Yes, you must submit a separate form for EACH student.

What are the criteria for allowing my child to attend in-person classes?


The student must have a temperature below 100.4°F and must answer NO to all of the symptom and exposure questions. If these requirements are not met, please do not send your student to school and contact the school for further instructions.

Do I need to submit a form if my child is sick?

A form should be submitted every day when your child is attending in person, even if you know they have a temperature you still complete and submit the form. This will allow the school to have data. If your child is doing synchronous learning then you wouldn't need to submit a form.

What do I need to do before the first day of school?

All families are strongly encouraged to use this time to ensure that you are able to successfully bring up the form and submit answers to the questions. You can practice by submitting as many forms as you would like before the first day of school. All data submitted before the first day of school will be considered as test data and will be discarded.



GRADES 1 - 8 COVID DISMISSAL TRAFFIC FLOW


