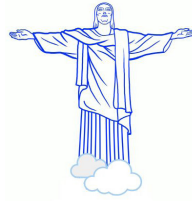

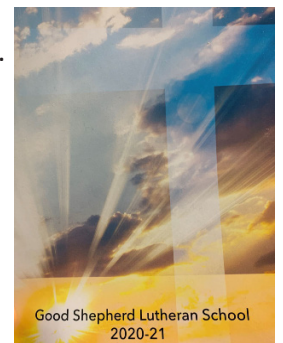
Volleyball and Basketball Camp Deadline Extended
