## Vacation Bible School

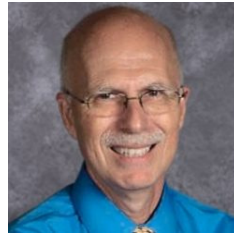

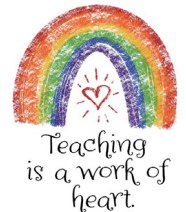


## MELHS Summer Sports Camps

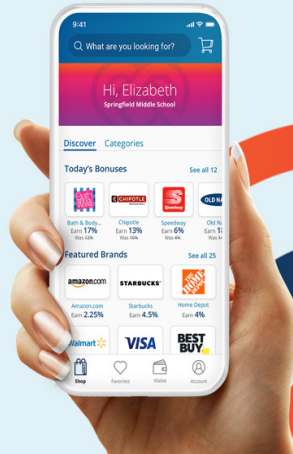

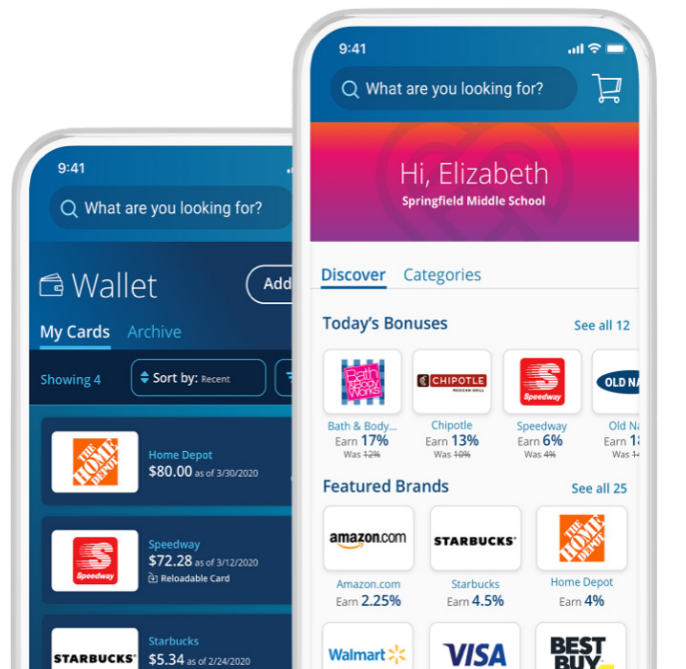
