Seven Ways Parents Can Help Students Become Better Learners

One of the best known followers of Jesus Christ, the Apostle Paul, wrote: "Study to show thyself approved unto God..." (II Timothy 2:15). It is impossible to study without basic academic skills. That is why Christian school educators place a heavy emphasis on reading, math, and writing skills. Christian schools remain committed to basic learning.

Learning is a united effort. Everyone must help if students are to learn and to improve upon their skills. Teachers, of course, are a major factor, but parents can make a significant difference in a student's academic success.
