I hope you are all enjoying this wonderful time of year!

As 2021 comes to a close, we are beginning to plan for the 2022-2023 school year. A huge part of the planning process is determining our staffing needs, which is based on enrollment.

We have simplified the reenrollment process this year! We are so excited that we can bring you automatic reenrollment beginning in January for the 2022-2023 school year. Most of our families intend to reenroll and do not need to update anything from year to year. Our new process requires you to do NOTHING. Your student(s) will be automatically reenrolled, and your FACTS financial plan will automatically roll into next school year as well. If you do wish to make a change or select a different payment plan, it is easy to log in and update that in your family portal. If you are not planning for your student(s) to attend, you will simply need to send an email as soon as possible but no later than February 1, 2022, to <u>ahites@gslcs.org</u>.

Enrollment opens to the public on January 3rd, 2022. If you have friends, family or neighbors that may be interested in enrolling for the 2022-2023 school year, please help us share this information. Have them reach out for a tour of our beautiful school! We would love to share the gift of a Christian Education with as many as we can.

Just like last year, we will invoice your nonrefundable registration fees in four installments. The installments will be due the following dates: February 15th, March 15th, April 15th and May 15th. The nonrefundable registration fees are staying the same as last year, \$205 for K-8 and \$100 for PreK, this is per student. If you prefer to pay the fees in one payment, please inform Andrea Hites via email. Again, to avoid being charged these nonrefundable fees if you are not enrolling for the 2022-2023 school year, simply send an email to <u>ahites@gslcs.org</u> no later than February 1^{, 2022}.

Step 1: Complete Application online at FACTS

- One application per household
 - * Includes Lutheran High Schools
 - * Divorce families must complete separate applications if both parents are paying tuition

Step 2: Submit payment for application (\$35)

Step 3: Submit ALL 2021 tax documents -

by April 10, 2022

• Applicant and co-applicant must submit tax docs

***Tax documents do not have to be filed; but must be prepared and submitted to your application

- CHECK EMAIL. FACTS representatives will email if documentation is missing. Please respond to the FACTS representatives if they contact you and check your junk folder for any FACTS emails.
- Documents can be uploaded to your application via PDF or picture taken with your mobile device
