- Step 2: Submit payment for application (\$35)

Step 3: Submit ALL 2021 tax documents -

#### by April 10, 2022

• Applicant and co-applicant must submit tax docs

\*\*\*Tax documents do not have to be filed; but must be prepared and submitted to your application

- CHECK EMAIL. FACTS representatives will email if documentation is missing. Please respond to the FACTS representatives if they contact you and check your junk folder for any FACTS emails.
- Documents can be uploaded to your application via PDF or picture taken with your mobile device
