- One application per household
  - \* Includes Lutheran High Schools
  - \* Divorce families must complete separate applications if both parents are paying tuition

**Step 2:** Submit payment for application (\$35)

Step 3: Submit ALL 2021 tax documents -

by April 10, 2022

- Applicant and co-applicant must submit tax docs
  - \*\*\*Tax documents do not have to be filed; but must be prepared and submitted to your application
- CHECK EMAIL. FACTS representatives will email if documentation is missing. Please respond to the FACTS representatives if they contact you and check your junk folder for any FACTS emails.
- Documents can be uploaded to your application via
   PDF or picture taken with your mobile device

Many families will qualify for some level of assistance from LESA if at least 10% of income from 2021 is used to cover the cost of their child/children's Lutheran K-8 net tuition.


