

Tuition Assistance

Step 1: Complete Application online at FACTS

- https://online.factsmgt.com/ga/inst-application/inst/4FG82
- One application per household
 - * Includes Lutheran High Schools
 - * Divorce families must complete separate applications if both parents are paying tuition

Step 2: Submit payment for application (\$35)

Step 3: Submit ALL 2021 tax documents -

by **April 10, 2022**

- Applicant and co-applicant must submit tax docs
 - ***Tax documents do not have to be filed; but must be prepared and submitted to your application
- CHECK EMAIL. FACTS representatives will email if documentation is missing. Please respond to the FACTS representatives if they contact you and check your junk folder for any FACTS emails.
- Documents can be uploaded to your application via
 PDF or picture taken with your mobile device

Submit by April 10, 2022

2021 Tax Documents

- 1) 1040 form (page 1 & 2)
- 2) W-2s
- 3) Income docs
 - > Schedule 1 5, C, E, K, etc.
- 4) Non-taxable docs
 - > Child support, SNAP, Welfare, Social Security
- 5) Corporate, Partnership, &/or trust tax forms
- 6) Other docs may be required
 - > Household bills, daycare, etc
