REQUIRED HEALTH FORMS FOR NEXT SCHOOL YEAR

Students in Kindergarten, 2nd grade and 6th grade and need updated Illinois health forms. The forms should be given or sent to the school office **BEFORE** the start of school:

Kindergarten: New physical, dental, and eye exams

2nd Grade: New Dental exam. Current physical including 2nd Varicella. 6th Grade: New physical including the DTAP, Meningococcal, and second varicella (chicken pox) booster.

Any student transferring from another school or state, is required to provide a current physical and dental record.
