A Special Thank You!


This has been a special year filled

REQUIRED HEALTH FORMS FOR 2022-2023

Students in Kindergarten, 2nd grade and 6th grade need updated Illinois health forms. The forms should be given or sent to the school office **BEFORE** the start of school:

Kindergarten: New physical, dental, and eye exams

2nd Grade: New Dental exam. Current physical including 2nd Varicella.

6th Grade: New physical including the DTAP, Meningococcal, and second varicella (chicken pox)

booster. New Dental exam.

Any student transferring from another school or state, is required to provide a current physical and dental record.
