Dismissal Diagram

Last week's newsletter focused on the "Arrival Drop Off Diagram" Please see the attached diagram for clarification on Charger News at gslcs.org. questions are welcome.

This week we will focus on the "Dismissal Diagram". There are two lanes for grade 1-8 coming into the parking lot. The first one is straight passed the church by the yellow curb. **Do not block the entrance for the ECC families pick up line**, which goes to the right of the parking lot around the church to the ECC. As you enter the parking lot, drive to the left to go down that lane that is called the "J-Curve", which winds around the parking lot to the cone by the far island. Do not block Beltline Road and Bridle Ridge. If the main dismissal line is full use the other "J-Curve" to help with traffic control. A helpful hint is to come later around 3:25. The big rush is at 3:15. Thank you for making arrival and dismissal a safe place for our children! 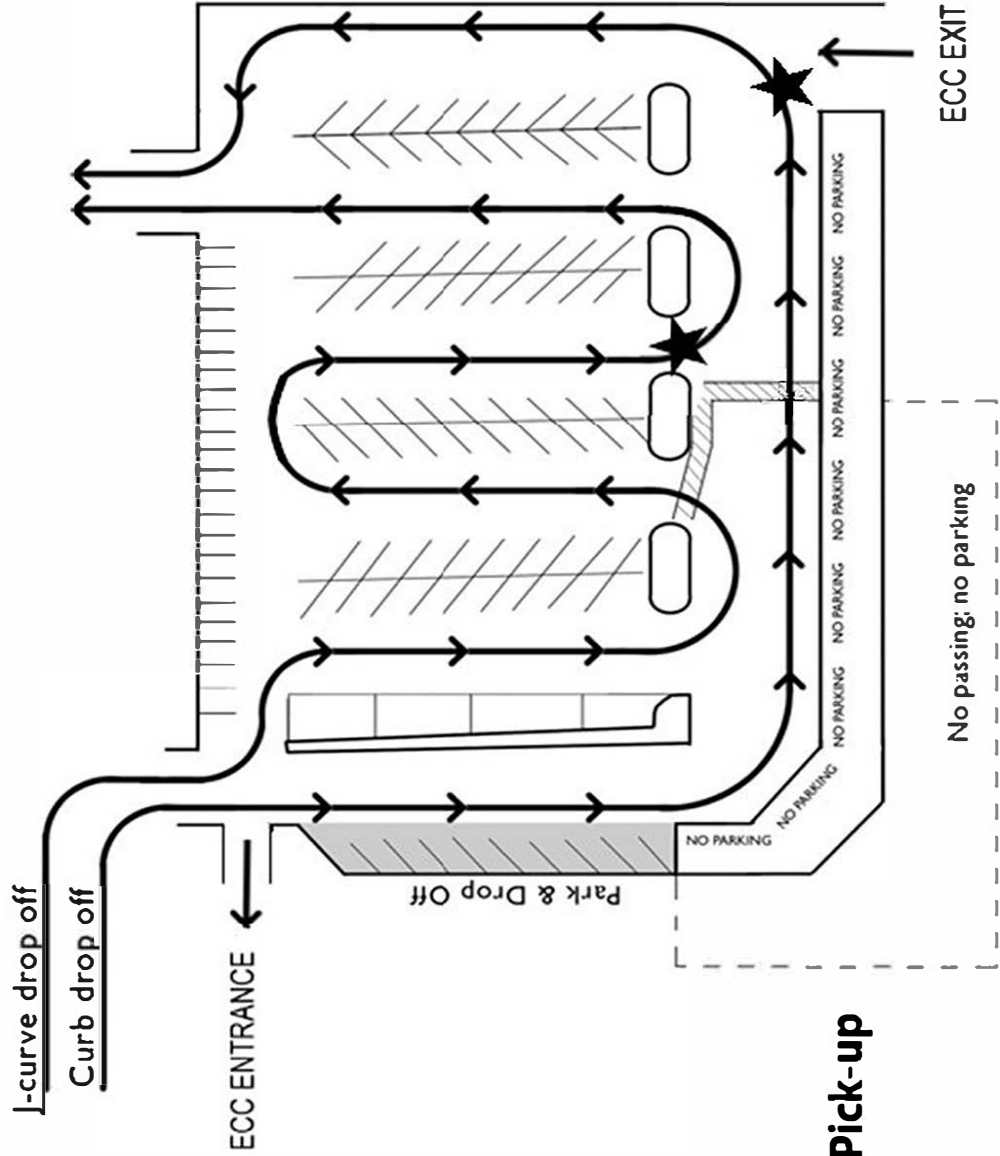

Good Shepherd Lutheran School's Scrip Program

What is Scrip?

Scrip is a tuition reduction program for school families and friends.

You simply order gift cards to pay for things you would normally be purchasing. Good Shepherd families share an extra benefit by participating in the program because they earn credits which reduce the cost of their tuition payment based on their individual spending. Participating families will receive credits posted to their family tuition account in February and August. The credits are split 50/50 for reduction of your tuition and the school's general fund.

Orders may be placed by turning in a green sheet with a check or exact cash. Please have your child turn the order in to the school office or give it to their teacher. These orders will be filled on weeks when school is in session a full five days. They will be given to your child's teacher on Friday to be sent home.

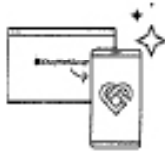

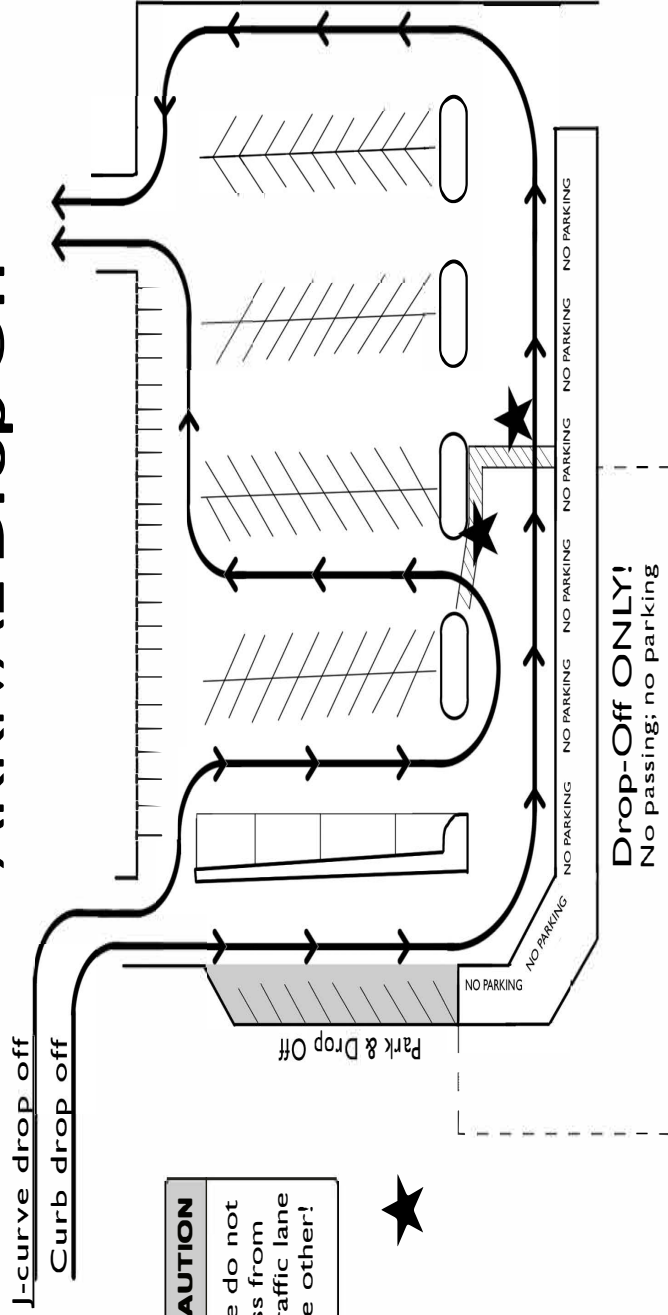
