HELP NEEDED TO KEEP SCHOLARSHIPS

The Invest in Kids Tax Credit Scholarship Program in Illinois began as a pilot program in 2017. It offers a 75% income tax credit to individuals and businesses that contribute to an SGO (e.g. Empower Illinois.) Empower Illinois then provides scholarships for students whose families meet the income requirements to attend qualified, non-public schools in Illinois (Good Shepherd.)

The original bill had an ending (sunset) date of December 31, 2023. An amendment has been created asking our Illinois legislators to amend the original bill, Invest in Kids, and remove the sunset date. How can you help?
