The Invest in Kids Tax Credit Scholarship Program offers a 75% income tax credit to individuals and businesses that contribute to an SGO (e.g. Empower Illinois.) Empower Illinois then provides scholarships for students whose families meet the income requirements to attend qualified, non-public schools in Illinois (Good Shepherd.)

The original bill had an ending (sunset) date of December 31, 2023. An amendment has been created asking our Illinois legislators to amend the bill and remove the sunset date. How can you help? 
