Cold and flu season has arrived. Please continue to be vigilant with your efforts to avoid the spread of germs. As a reminder, your child must stay home if they have a fever of 100.0° Fahrenheit (38° Centigrade) or higher. Wait at least 24 hours after the fever has come down and stabilized without medication before considering sending your child back to school.

We will call you to come pick up your child if their temperature is above 100°F or if vomiting has occurred while at school.


GIRLS BASKETBALL SCHEDULE CHANGE

SCHOOL AND LUNCH PROGRAM ARE HIRING!



We are growing and are in the process of searching for great people to serve in these positions:

The **Preschool and TRACKS** programs, are looking for individuals who enjoy children, have a positive attitude, and effective communication skills. This is part-time employment during the school day and/or after school.

The Lunch Program is in need of a part-time individual to help prepare and serve lunches.

The school is also accepting applications for a **Christian Counselor** who will serve 7 to 8 students, one day per week. This individual will serve as a resource person for students, faculty, staff and parents, giving healthy and effective alternatives to problems in these areas: Leadership, Citizenship, Crisis Management, Understanding of Others, Coping Skills, Self-image, Emotional Development, Loss, Conflict Resolution, Healthy Family Relationships, and Decision Making.

And...we are accepting applications for a part-time, 16 hours per week, **Development Coordinator**. Primary responsibilities are threefold: this position is responsible for 1) developing and implementing strategies, in collaboration with the Principal, the Fund Development and Marketing Committee of the Board of Day School, and staff, to achieve revenue goals established in the Day School strategic plan, 2) raising awareness of Good Shepherd Lutheran School as an educational option for families in the metro east and Southern Illinois areas, and 3) working with GSLS staff to build and maintain relationships with school families to sustain and advance Good Shepherd's mission.
