GSLS IS HIRING!

We are growing and are in the process of searching for great people to serve in these positions:

In the **Preschool and TRACKS** program, we are looking for individuals who enjoy providing care for children, have a positive attitude, and effective communication skills. This is part-time employment during the school day and/or after school.

We are also accepting applications for a **Christian Counselor** who will serve 7 to 8 students, one day per week. This individual will serve as a resource person for students, faculty, staff and parents, giving healthy and effective alternatives to problems in these areas: Leadership, Citizenship, Crisis Management, Understanding of Others, Coping Skills, Self-image, Emotional Development, Loss, Conflict Resolution, Healthy Family Relationships, and Decision Making.

And...we are accepting applications for a part-time, 16 hours per week, **Development Coordinator**. Primary responsibilities are threefold: this position is responsible for 1) developing and implementing strategies, in collaboration with the Principal, the Fund Development and Marketing Committee of the Board of Day School, and staff, to achieve revenue goals established in the Day School strategic plan, 2) raising awareness of Good Shepherd Lutheran School as an educational option for families in the metro east and Southern Illinois areas, and 3) working with GSLS staff to build and maintain relationships with school families to sustain and advance Good Shepherd's mission.

Really Afraid Sometimes I feel really afraid. What can I do when I am overcome by fear?

When they saw him walking on the water, they cried out in terror... Jesus spoke to them at once. "Don't be afraid," he said, "Take courage! I am here!" Mark 6:49-50

Why did Jesus tell all those people not be be afraid? He knew that fear would paralyze them. It keeps you from moving out in courage to do things God wants you to do. It keeps you from trusting God to take care of you. It convinces you that you will fail, that you will let others down, and that God will not help when you need it most. In short, fear consumes you until you can't think straight. When you are frightened, stop and focus on God. Picture him fighting by your side and your fear will begin to melt away.
