

3rd Grade = Adventure Club (camping, hiking, and outdoor equipment/supplies, etc.)


4th Grade = Drama Club (anything for movie lovers; snacks, movies, gift cards, entertainment items, etc.)

Step 2: Submit payment for application (\$35)

Step 3: Submit **ALL 2022** tax documents

- Applicant & co-applicant must submit tax docs
- Taxes do not have to be filed, but must be prepared and uploaded to application

Step 4: CHECK EMAIL

- FACTS representatives will email if documentation is missing. Please respond as soon as possible and check your junk folder for FACTS emails.

Required Documentation

- 2022—1040 Tax Form (page 1 & 2)
- 2022 W2
- · Business Income docs
 - ⇒ Schedule 1—5, C, E, K, etc.
- Non-taxable docs
 - ⇒ Child support, SNAP, TANF, Social Security

Do You Qualify?

Families will qualify for some level of assistance from LESA if at least 10% of income from 2022 is used to cover the cost of their child/children's Lutheran K-8 net tuition.
