HEARTS FOR JESUS CHAPEL OFFERINGS

February's Chapel Offerings will be going to the Garuna Christian School Ministry in Cambodia. This Lutheran ministry is operating 7 schools in Cambodia, with 2 more schools under construction, opening in 2023. Garuna means "grace" in the Khmer language, and the students are called "Garuna Kids". There are currently over 1,300



Garuna Kids who are learning about Jesus each day. Our offerings will help the Garuna Kids in a country where only 2% trust in Jesus. Our gifts help send these children to school where they learn Bible, math, the Khmer (Cambodian) language, and basic English in grades K-6. Each student receives a uniform, backpack, school supplies, textbooks, and an opportunity to learn about Jesus.

 year.


GUIDELINES:

Step 1: Complete application online through FACTS

Step 2: Submit payment for application (\$35)

Step 3: Submit ALL 2022 tax documents

- Applicant & co-applicant must submit tax docs
- Taxes do not have to be filed, but must be prepared and uploaded to application

Step 4: CHECK EMAIL

- FACTS representatives will email if documentation is missing. Please respond as soon as possible and check your junk folder for FACTS emails.

Required Documentation

- 2022—1040 Tax Form (page 1 & 2)
- 2022 W2
- Business Income docs
 - ⇒ Schedule 1-5, C, E, K, etc.
- Non-taxable docs
 - ⇒ Child support, SNAP, TANF, Social Security

Do You Qualify?

Families will qualify for some level of assistance from LESA if at least 10% of income from 2022 is used to cover the cost of their child/children's Lutheran K-8 net tuition.
