

## **CONGRESSIONAL AWARD GOLD MEDAL**

We are happy to share amazing news of a Good Shepherd Alum! Collinsville High School Sophomore, Danielle C. has earned the Congressional Award Gold Medal from the United States Congress, the highest level of congressional recognition available to America's civilian youth. The award is given annually to student leaders who have intentionally devoted their time to goal-setting and community engagement. The program requires each participant to select an advisor who will oversee their journey and sign off on the final application prior to submitting it. Danielle chose Mr. Krueger from Good Shepherd Lutheran School.



Theme

Danielle started working toward this goal in October 2020 when she turned 13.5 years old, which is the youngest you can be to register for the award program. To be eligible for the award, participants are expected to log a minimum of 400 hours of voluntary public service, 200 hours of personal development, 200 hours of physical fitness, and a five-day, four-night expedition or exploration. Danielle's volunteer hours consisted of working with the Caseyville Public Library, the Disabled American Veterans, and Girl Scouts. Her personal development goals included teaching herself to play the ukulele and becoming certified in scuba diving. Her physical fitness hour goals revolved around her training and advancement in martial arts at McArther's Taekwondo & Fitness. Lastly, her exploration was an adventurous trip to Curacao where she hiked, scuba-dived, and explored the landscape, historical monuments, and culture of the island.

By earning the Gold Medal, Danielle also earned the Bronze, Silver, and Gold Certificates, as well as the Bronze and Silver Medal, which she received in the mail. She has been invited to attend the Gold Award Summit in Washington D.C. in June 2023 to be recognized and receive her Gold Medal. Congratulations Danielle!

**Step 2:** Submit payment for application (\$35)

Step 3: Submit ALL 2022 tax documents

- Applicant & co-applicant must submit tax docs
- Taxes do not have to be filed, but must be prepared and uploaded to application

## **Step 4: CHECK EMAIL**

- FACTS representatives will email if documentation is missing. Please respond as soon as possible and check your junk folder for FACTS emails.

## **Required Documentation**

- 2022—1040 Tax Form (page 1 & 2)
- 2022 W2
- Business Income docs
  - ⇒ Schedule 1—5, C, E, K, etc.
- Non-taxable docs
  - ⇒ Child support, SNAP, TANF, Social Security

## Do You Qualify?

Families will qualify for some level of assistance from LESA if at least 10% of income from 2022 is used to cover the cost of their child/children's Lutheran K-8 net tuition.
