## PARENTS OF KDG, 2ND AND 6TH GRADE STUDENTS

Students entering Kindergarten, 2nd grade and 6th grade need updated health forms for the State of Illinois. The forms should be given or sent to the school office **BEFORE** the start of school on August 17th:

**Kindergarten** - Needs New physical, dental, and eye exams **2nd Grade** - Needs New Dental exam. Current vaccinations must include 2nd Varicella.

**6th Grade** - Needs New physical including the DTAP, Meningococcal, and second varicella (chicken pox) booster.
