PARENTS OF KDG, 2ND AND 6TH GRADE STUDENTS

Students entering Kindergarten, 2nd, and 6th grade need updated health forms for the State of Illinois. The school office should receive them **<u>BEFORE</u>** the start of school on August 17th:

Kindergarten - Needs New physical, dental, and eye exams

2nd Grade - Needs New Dental exam. Current vaccinations must include 2nd Varicella. 6th Grade - Needs New physical including the DTAP, Meningococcal, and second varicella (chicken pox) booster.

Any student transferring from another school or state, is required to provide a current physical and dental record.
