## Grades 3-5

#### Grade 6

They will be introduced to proper player positions such as: setter, outside attacker, middle attacker, etc. Team play will be stressed.

We will also introduce drills that will help them become more proficient at these skills along with attacking, blocking, multiple offenses, and multiple defenses.
