Student Safety

Please review the following safety rules:

1. All vehicles picking up students should have a sign in the front window with student'(s') last name and

grade(s). Legible handwritten sign is acceptable.

2. The pickup and dropoff lines are considered child zones and the driver's cell phone should not be in use when children are present.

3. Please do not pass the car in front of you unless instructed to do so by school personnel.

4. In the morning, if you are in a hurry or you have slow moving children, please park your car and let your children cross the parking lot using the crosswalks.

5. Please be aware of crosswalks and do not block them. Allow students to have a clear path to walk safely.

6. If your child is going to arrive after 8:15 a.m., an adult should plan to come to the office and sign them in.

Message from Our Counselor

As kids get older, many parents may find themselves struggling to connect with their child. We may ask our kids questions and get a nod or a shrug, and let's



face it, there may be times we get no response at all. Technology has started to replace a lot of in person interaction, and while technology is a great resource, it cannot effectively replace the face-to-face human connection that we are designed for.

I want to take a moment to talk about a couple of ways to help start conversations each day with your kids. The first and most important step is to create a space free from distraction. You want to make sure to focus on what your child has to say. We're interested! Once this space is created, then ask open ended questions about them and about their day. Finally, offer something positive about the interaction. An example could be, "Thanks so much for sitting and talking with me" or "I really love hearing about your day." These distraction free moments of genuine conversation are great for building social skills that will last your child a lifetime and most importantly, it lets your child know you're listening. - Tiffany Peek
