



**Step 1:** Complete application online through FACTS

**Step 2:** Submit payment for application (\$40)

Step 3: Submit ALL 2023 tax documents

- Applicant & co-applicant must submit tax docs
- Taxes do not have to be filed, but must be prepared and uploaded to application
- Call LESA office with any questions

#### **Step 4: CHECK EMAIL**

- FACTS representatives will email if documentation is missing. Please respond as soon as possible and check your junk folder for FACTS emails.

#### **Required Documentation**

- 2023—1040 Tax Form (page 1 & 2)
- 2023 W2(s)
- Business Income docs
  - $\Rightarrow$  Schedule 1—5, C, E, K, etc.
- Non-taxable docs
  - ⇒ Child support, SNAP, TANF, Social Security

#### Do You Qualify?

- 1. If at least 10% of income from 2023 is used to cover the cost of a child/children's Lutheran K-8 net tuition
- 2. Child/children must be enrolled at the school by April 30 to be eligible for a scholarship during the May awards

- 2. On the homepage you will see the option to Buy Tickets or Register. If you are attending the dinner, click Buy Tickets. When you buy your dinner ticket you are already registered for the silent auction and will receive a paddle number. If you wish to support Good Shepherd in the silent auction only, you will click, Register.
