Pastor's Corner -

This Sunday we begin Holy Week. Holy Week is a very sacred time of the year, for during Holy Week we will commemorate and remember the last week of Jesus' life on this earth. These are the days leading up to the great Easter Feast. The Lenten season of sacrifice and self-denial is about to come to an end, but this coming week is extremely important for all Christians. The greatest focus of the week is the Passion (suffering) and Resurrection of Jesus Christ and the events that led up to it.



Holy week begins on Sunday, March 24th with Palm Sunday and ends on Sunday, March 31st with Easter. Over the years, this week has been considered the most important and holy time in the life of the church—especially what is known as the "Triduum" — or Great Three Days — of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter morning.

Join us for our worship during Holy Week, as we contemplate the suffering, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

On Palm Sunday we will hold our palms and we will hear The Gospel of our Lord entering Jerusalem on a donkey. On Holy Thursday we will give Him thanks that He has given us The Sacrament of His Body and Blood, and on Good Friday we will kneel at the foot of His Cross to give Him thanks that He died to take away our sins. On Easter morning we will joyously celebrate the Resurrection of our Lord. Most importantly, at all of our services, our Risen Lord comes to us and gives us the gifts of the forgiveness of sins, eternal life, and salvation!

Teachers for 2024-25



- 2. On the homepage you will see the option to Buy Tickets or Register. If you are attending the dinner, click Buy Tickets. When you buy your dinner ticket you are already registered for the silent auction and will receive a paddle number. If you wish to support Good Shepherd in the silent auction only, you will click, Register.
- 3. There are two ticket options. You as the purchaser will add the names of your guests. Adding an email address for each guest will allow you to send an invite to your guest so they can complete their registration and receive a paddle number.

 - b. Table Ticket This option allows you to buy a table of 10 tickets.
