#### Pastor's Corner -


18 But what God foretold by the mouth of all the prophets, that his Christ would suffer, he thus fulfilled. 19 Repent therefore, and turn back, that your sins may be blotted out, 20 that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, and that he may send the Christ appointed for you, Jesus, 21 whom heaven must receive until the time for restoring all the things about which God spoke by the mouth of his holy prophets long ago. - Acts 3:18–21 (ESV)



The word for "refreshing" in this passage carries the idea of getting a cold drink and some shade after you've been out in the scorching heat of the day. True rest, true refreshment for body and soul is found in the gifts of God as they are given to us in church week in and week out. The Lord gives us the Third Commandment (Remember the Sabbath Day by keeping it holy) for our good. The services at church are first and foremost a time when God comes to us in His Word and Sacraments (baptism and the Lord's Supper) to give us the forgiveness of sins, eternal life, and salvation. It is only after God has done His work in and for us that we then respond with worship, prayer, and praise. It is in the presence of the Lord that we find the times of refreshing that bring true hope and joy.


## **Blood Drive**

## Grades 3-5

Time:

This session is designed to emphasize the basic volleyball skills such as: serving, passing, setting, receiving, offense and defense. They will be introduced to proper player positions. They will learn the proper volleyball terminology. Individual skills as well as team play will be stressed. Enjoyment of the game will also be stressed.

#### Grade 6

This session is designed to emphasize the basic volleyball skills such as: serving, passing, setting, offense and defense.

They will be introduced to proper player positions such as: setter, outside attacker, middle attacker, etc. Team play will be stressed.

## **Grades 7 & 8**

This session is designed for girls to prepare them for Jr. High level of play when the season begins. We will stress the basic skills such as: serving, passing, setting, digging and team play. We will also introduce drills that will help them become more proficient at these skills along with attacking, blocking, multiple offenses, and multiple defenses.
