Required Health Forms for 2024-25 School Year

Students starting Kindergarten, 2nd grade and 6th grade need updated Illinois health forms. Please make your appointments now so you can give or send the completed forms to the school office **BEFORE** the start of school:

Kindergarten: New physical, dental, and eye exams

2nd Grade: New Dental exam. Current physical including 2nd Varicella. **6th Grade:** New physical including the DTAP, Meningococcal, and second varicella (chicken pox) booster.

Any student transferring from another school or state, is required to provide a current physical and dental record.

Conflict with peers is a very common occurrence with kids. Conflict resolution is a valuable skill for them to begin learning at an early age. Let's talk about some ways that we can help teach our kids this skill. These are just a few skills that can help kids navigate difficult situations with peers.

- Stop and think about the problem.
- Think about what you're feeling at that moment (can you handle it yourself or do you need help?)
- Talk it out (make sure we are using kind words and helpful language)
- Practice brainstorming- if we just can't agree, sometimes brainstorming can help us find a compromise.

Spring Pops Concert @ MELHS, Sunday May 12th


