Something to Consider...

Holy Week is the most sacred week in the Christian calendar, marking the final days of Jesus Christ's life on Earth, leading up to His resurrection on Easter Sunday. It's a time of deep reflection, prayer, and remembrance.

Here's a quick breakdown of the key days:

Palm Sunday: Celebrates Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem, where people greeted Him with palm branches—symbolizing peace and victory.

Holy Monday to Wednesday: These days recall various events of Jesus' final week, including His teachings, His time at the temple, and the growing tension with religious leaders.

Maundy Thursday: Commemorates the Last Supper, where Jesus shared a final meal with His disciples and instituted the practice of Communion (the Eucharist).

Good Friday: A solemn day remembering Jesus' suffering and crucifixion. It's called "good" because of the sacrifice Jesus made for humanity's redemption.

Holy Saturday: A quiet, reflective day

Holy Saturday: A quiet, reflective day marking the time Jesus' body lay in the tomb.

Easter Sunday: The most joyous day—celebrating Jesus' resurrection from the dead, symbolizing victory over sin and death, and bringing hope of new life. Blessings!

Physical Education Teacher


