Pastor's Corner - Pastor Packer

This is a helpful summary of the themes for this coming Sunday: Our Lord Jesus is the Good Shepherd (John 10:11-16). He is not like the hireling, who cares nothing for the sheep and only for himself, who flees when he sees the wolf coming. Rather, Jesus is the Good Shepherd who seeks out His scattered sheep to deliver them (Ezek. 34:11–16). He gathers them and feeds them in rich pasture. He binds up the broken and strengthens the sick. He lays down His life for wandering and wayward sheep. On the cross, Christ bore in His body the attacks of the predators of sin and death and the devil for you that you might be saved. He now lives to restore your soul in the still waters of baptism, to lead you in the paths of righteousness by the voice of His Gospel, to prepare the table of His holy supper before you, that you may dwell in the house of the Lord forever (Psalm 23). "For you were straying like sheep, but have now returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls" (1 Peter 2:25).

St Louis Cardinals Baseball Tickets

Cardinal tickets are on sale now! Anyone can purchase from us, so please share! See the attached flier and details! Tickets should be purchased through this **GOOGLE FORM** link https://forms.gle/S9zB2zKHoGiTNnwF7. The orders will be processed after the order form closes on **Tuesday, May 13th**. Receipt of payment in the office is required prior to receiving tickets. Tickets will be distributed around **May 16th**. Send money to the school office or if you don't have a child in school, send a check by mail to Good Shepherd Lutheran School attn: Zach Stegman-Music, 1300 Beltline Road, Collinsville, IL 62234. Our Music Program receives a profit of \$0.85 per ticket sold, only if we sell all of our 350 tickets.

Game: **Tuesday, June 3rd, 2025** 6:45 PM game time Cardinals game #28 vs. Kansas City Royals Tickets are in the Lower Left Field Box and Left Field Box-sections 165, 166, or 167.

Good Shepherd Lutheran School students currently in K-8th grade will sing "God Bless America" before the game begins, approximately 6:30 PM. COST: \$20 per ticket (printed face value of ticket reads \$50) Students wishing to sing God Bless America at the game **MUST** buy a ticket from GSLS. No outside tickets for singers. Students must have ticket in hand with a guardian phone number written on it when it is time to go on field. You must also indicate on the Google Form the singers' names and include the email address where you would like the singing information sent.

Promotional items: A picture of promotional items follows the newsletter. It includes an XL National League jersey, a Youth Medium black/neon Cardinals jersey, a Scott Rolen bobblehead, 2 hanging growth charts featuring a Cardinals player, and 2 packs of baseball cards.


The first person to purchase 25 tickets, 20 tickets, 15 tickets, 10 tickets, and 5 tickets will get their choice of items. The items will be chosen on **Tuesday, May 13th** with the first 25 ticket purchasers getting first pick, then the first 20 ticket purchasers etc.

Please note, sadly, this year the Cardinals are not providing us a free hot dog and soda with ticket purchase.

PLEASE, PLEASE spread the word to friends/co-workers/neighbors. **ANYONE** can buy tickets from us! Please share the Google form link or call the school office at 618-344-3153 and ask about ticket sales.

Important notes: GSLS has sold tickets and sung at the Cardinals game for almost 10 years as a fun opportunity for families and friends and also as a fundraiser. Provided we sell all 350 of our consigned tickets, we will profit \$0.85 per ticket. Our purchase price from the Cardinals is \$19.15. We are not making a huge profit. The Cardinals have raised prices AND raised our minimum sales requirement, so this is falling more into the fun opportunity category than fundraiser. We will continue to offer this activity as long as tickets sell. If we have trouble selling tickets, we will have to discontinue this event for future years. It just depends on the interest level of our families.

Additional Details and Disclaimers: All students who are currently in K-8th may participate in the singing. Students MUST have their ticket in hand to show and be scanned by the Cardinals security before they enter the secure area of Busch Stadium and go on field for the singing. It is the guardian's responsibility to write down their cell number and put it in the pocket of their student (all ages) so that we can contact you on your cell phone in case of illness or another problem once we take the students into the secure area. Tickets are not refundable. Our contract with the Cardinals states that we must sell at least 350 tickets in order to sing. This has never been a problem for us in the past. If rain would occur, the cardinals rain out policy would go into effect and we may OR may not reschedule the singing depending on a number of factors. Write down your ticket information as soon as you receive them in case they are lost or stolen and you need to contact the cardinals to get them reprinted. Students may wear comfortable clothes, there is no specific color or dress for this time, though we ask that the students leave hats with their families so their faces can be seen.
