Sports Physicals - 2025-2026

A Sports Physical and Concussion Form is required if your child will be participating in Boys Baseball, Boys or Girls Basketball, Girls Volleyball, Cross Country, or Track. A Sports Physical is not required for 6th grade athletes as their required medical exam fulfills this requirement. Is Your Student Entering Kdg, 2nd, or 6th Grade in the Fall?

If so, please see the requirements below and schedule your child(ren)'s appointments NOW. The school office should receive the forms **BEFORE** the start of school (copies can be emailed to ncluck@gslcs.org):

Kindergarten: New physical, dental, and eye exams

2nd Grade: New Dental exam. Current physical, 2nd Varicella.

6th Grade: New physical including the DTAP, Meningococcal, and second varicella (chicken pox) booster.




