- Audition forms must also be submitted to the school office, your child's teacher, or by email to Mrs. Batty
 or Mr. Lingel. Please complete the following information as it should appear in the program.
- All auditions must be submitted no later than Friday, October 24th.
- All acts should be presented just as they will be performed on the night of the Variety Show. If you are
 not prepared to perform your act as you would the night of the Variety Show, please save your act for next
 year.

GUIDELINES:

- There will be a 4-minute time limit for each performance. (Some performances may, by their very nature, be much shorter than a full 4-minute slot.)
- All acts must exemplify the standards of Good Shepherd Lutheran School. (This includes musical selection, lyrics, and manner of dress.)
- Each act will be required to audition. Please have sheet music or a music file, <u>and</u> a copy of the lyrics. (The Internet provides sites for hard-to-find lyrics.)
- Each person auditioning must turn in a permission slip signed by a parent/guardian.

Please plan to attend the dress rehearsal on Monday, November 3rd, beginning at 3:15 P.M.
